The Basque & Cultural Center preserves, promotes and perpetuates Basque history and culture. As the only Basque Museum in the United States, their vision is to be an international leader showcasing Basque history and culture and connecting people to Basque experiences in the world.

HISTORY OF THE MUSEUM

Established in 1985, through the efforts of many individuals, businesses and foundations, the Basque Museum & Cultural Center has continued to grow and expand its facilities and programs. The museum first opened in the Cyrus Jacobs/Uberuaga House, but in 1993 created the first permanent exhibits to occupy the gallery on the adjacent property at 611 Grove. The larger facility provided space for an expanded museum store, collection storage, and cultural center area for language classes and social gatherings.
